IMPORTANT IES Fall Deadlines

There are a few deadline dates that are coming up very soon that you need to be aware of.

- 1:1 meeting: The deadline for Scholars that have been chosen to have a 1:1 meeting is *Friday, December 8th by*5:00 PM. You have until the course deadline on Monday, Dec. 11th at 5:00 PM to submit your 1:1 meeting.
- Group Connect & Events: All scholars must have their Group Connect & Events submitted through Bb by 5:00 PM on Monday, Dec. 11th. These submissions will be deactivated at that time and there will be no late submissions accepted.
- **Service Hours:** Scholars have until <u>Dec. 31st</u> to complete this requirement for Fall. This is the only "assignment" that will stay active throughout the Winter break. Last day to submit Fall service hours will be 5:00 PM on Jan. 16, 2024.
